The Handwriting Practice Book is part of the Pegasus Handwriting Practice Series designed to help the child master handwriting skills in no time.

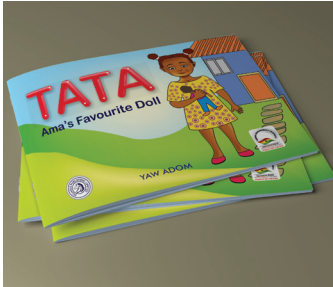

The Pegasus Handwriting Practice Series are the most thorough and comprehensive learning guides available, offering high-interest lessons together with full colour illustrations to encourage learning.

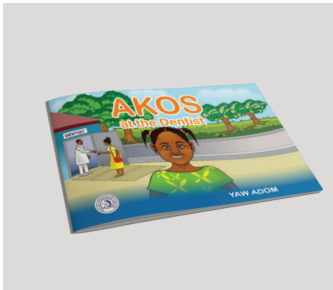
How to use this book:

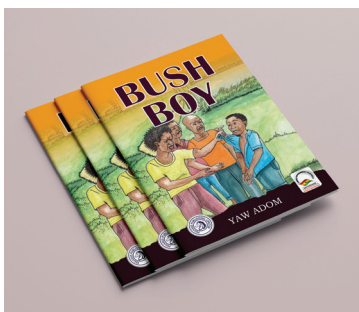
SUPPLEMENTARY READERS
